

***** SENIORS ALERT *****

***** DISABLED PERSONS ALERT *****

Due to an Executive Order and subsequent legislation by New York State, senior citizens with limited incomes and persons with disabilities and limited incomes who are receiving a property tax exemption on their 2020/21 tax bill are **NOT REQUIRED** to renew their application with our office.

This legislation allows you to stay safely in your homes while allowing your current exemption to roll over into next year (2021/22) without the requirement of a renewal application.

However, if your **2019 or 2020** income is **less** than that which we have on file, and would result in a greater exemption, you must provide us with a renewal application and a copy of the income tax returns that would support the greater exemption, **no later than March 1, 2021**. Please call our office for guidance on this or any other matter.

ALERT: If there has been a change in ownership, residency, if the property owner has died, or other reason why you may no longer be eligible for either of these exemptions, **you must renew your application with us by March 1, 2021** and report the reason for change to our office immediately.
