

Minutes of a joint meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead and the Town Board of the Town of Southampton held in the Riverhead Town Offices Wednesday, December 27th, 1922. Called for the purpose of discussing the widening of Peconic Ave. at the Town lines and the Bridge. A majority of the members being present.

On motion made seconded and carried Supervisor Dennis G. Homan was appointed chairman of this meeting.

Mr. Robert P. Griffing and Mr. William F. Morrell of this village appeared before the meeting and stated that they were willing to co-operate in any way with the two Town Board and whatever the Boards decide upon will be satisfactory to them.

On motion made seconded and carried Town Clerk Frank Sollar was instructed to notify the different property owners having buildings which enroach the highway on the east side of Peconic Ave to have such parts of their buildings removed by June 1st, 1923.

On motion made seconded and carried that the Town Sup't of Highways of the Town of Southampton and the Town Sup't of Highways of the Town of Riverhead get together and extend the bridge eighteen feet on Peconic Ave. at the Town Lines and that they do the work as expeditiously as possible and the cost thereof shall be borne by the two towns.

There being no further business meeting adjourned.
