Bids for supplying Road Oil were submitted *at* the following prices per gallon f. o. b. Riverhead Town.


Carson Petroleum Co.	.072

On motion made, seconded and carried it was ordered that this Board and the Town Superintendent of Highways enter into a contract with the Texas Company for supplying approximately 100,000 gallons of about 45% Asphalt Road oil at \$.0694 per gallon f.o.b. at the different Railroad Stations in Riverhead Town.

On motion made seconded and carried Supervisor E. Frank Howell was authorized to have appointed a Special Deputy Sheriff from this date and for a period of time that he deems necessary to regulate traffic on the streets of the Village of Riverhead.

Town Clerk, Joseph W. Kratoville submitted several different propositions for safe cabinets of Fire Proof construction and of Fire resisting construction to properly house maps, which ~~###~~ now have no protection from fire and at this meeting there was no action taken.
