

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Office, on Wednesday, October 30, 1929 at 2 P. M.

The minutes of the meeting of the Town Board of October 9th. and the minutes of the Special meeting of the Town Board held October 18, 1929 were read and on motion and vote adopted.

It was moved, seconded and carried that the Town Clerk write the Goldy Realty Company thanking said company for having the ruins of the Long Island House removed.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was RESOLVED that the days for instruction of the voting machines be October 31, November 1 and 2 and that the compensation of the instructors be and the same is hereby fixed at \$6.00 per day.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was RESOLVED That the Supervisor and the Town Clerk be and they hereby are authorized and directed to borrow upon certificates of indebtedness, the sum of \$5000.00 to pay on account of audited bills of October 29, 1929.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was RESOLVED That the Supervisor and the Town Clerk be and they hereby are authorized and directed to borrow upon certificates of indebtedness the sum of \$500.00 for the POOR FUND.

Mr. Julian Rubenstein, Zoning Commissioner was present and advised that the Zoning Commission appointed by the Town Board had met and organized.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was Resolved that the lighting committee investigate the street lighting situation on Peconic Avenue and make recommendations for improving same at the next meeting of the Town Board.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was RESOLVED that the committee having charge of locating suitable grounds for dumping rubbish, arrange with G. Leroy Wells for a one lease of property at Aquebogue with a privilege of renewal for not less than five years at \$100.00 per year.



An application was made by Howard S. Howell to the Town Superintendent of Highways to lay out a highway within the Town of Riverhead extending north from East Main Street between the lands of Howard S. Howell and William Lane to the southerly line or side of Elton Street, the land having been released and didicated to the Town by the owners, Howard S. Howell, Lillian Howell, Leone D. Howell, Lena F. Howell, Robert R. Howell and Clara Howell, Ida E. Howell, Rose E. Howell and Carrie Louisa Howell, on motion duly made, seconded and carried it was RESOLVED That this Board consent to the laying out of said highway to be known as " Howell Avenue " by the Town Superintendent of Highways.

There being no further business, on motion and vote, the meeting adjourned.
