

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on  
Tuesday, November 19, 1929 at 2 P.M.

Supervisor Homan being absent, it was moved, seconded and carried that Justice Burnside act as Chairman of the meeting.

The minutes of the regular meeting of the Town Board of October 30, 1929 and the minutes of the Special Meeting of the Board of November 9, 1929 were read and on motion and vote adopted.

A communication was read from Joseph Bowden of Patchogue applying for the position of Dog Warden and on motion and vote was held over until some future meeting of the Board.

A communication was received from residents of Millbrook Lane requesting that a street light be placed on said lane and said communication was referred to the lighting committee for investigation.

The lighting committee recommended that the two 600 C.P. suspension streetlights on Peconic Avenue be removed and that four 600 C.P. street lights be installed on Peconic Avenue in place thereof.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was Resolved That the Long Island Lighting Company be instructed to remove the two suspension street lights on Peconic Avenue and install four 600 C. P. street lights of the ornamental type on Peconic Avenue at points designated by the Lighting Committee of the Town Board.

Almon G. Rasquin was present and presented a petition from Riverhead Playhouse, Inc., requesting that this Board adopt an ordinance permitting the exhibition of motion pictures on Sunday.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was RESOLVED That the petition of Riverhead Playhouse, Inc. to allow the exhibition of motion pictures on Sunday be and the same hereby is held over until the next meeting of the Town Board.

The committee having charge of locating suitable ground for dumping rubbish presented a lease signed by G. Leroy Wells leasing land to the town at Aquebogue for a period of one year at \$100.00 *per year*

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was Resolved That this Board recommend that Charles O. Downs, Town Superintendent of Highways, execute lease with G. Leroy Wells for land for town dump.

There being no further business, on motion and vote the meeting adjourned.
