RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF AN APPLICATION FOR A FEDERAL AND STATE GRANT FOR THE PLANNING, DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OF NECESSARY SEWAGE TREATMENT WORKS, UNDER THE APPROPRIATE LAWS OF NEW YORK STATE AND THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA

WHEREAS, the Town of Riverhead herein called the "Applicant," (Legal Name of Applicant)

after thorough consideration of the various aspects of the problem and study of available data, has hereby determined that the planning, design and construction of certain works, required for the treatment of sewage, generally described as Scavenger Waste Treatment Facility

(Description of project used in Part 1, Box F of Application 5700-32)

and identified as Project Number C-36-0977-03-0, herein called the "Project," is desirable and in the public interest, and to that end it is necessary that action preliminary to the planning, design and construction of said Project be taken immediately; and

WHEREAS, under the Federal Water Pollution Control Act, as amended, the United States of America has authorized the making of grants to aid in financing the cost of planning, design and construction of necessary treatment works to prevent the discharge of untreated or inadequately treated sewage or other waste into any waters and for the purpose of reports, plans and specifications in connection therewith; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 659 of the Laws of 1972 of the State of New York provide financial aid for the planning, design and construction of Water Quality Improvement Projects; and

WHEREAS, the Applicant has examined and duly considered the Water Pollution Control Act, as Amended and Chapter 659 of the Laws of 1972 of the State of New York and the applicant deems it to be in the public interest and benefit to file an application under

That the filing of application in the form required by the State of New York and the United States and in conformity with the Water Pollution Control Act, as amended and Chapter 659 of the Laws of 1972 of the State of New York is hereby authorized including all understandings and assurances contained in said applications. That Joseph F. Janoski, Supervisor, (Title of Applicant's designated authorized representative) is directed and authorized as the official representative of the applicant to act in connection with the applications and to provide such additional information as may be required; That, for the purposes of New York State Finance Law, 3. Joseph F. Janoski, Supervisor, be designated as Fiscal Officer (Title of Applicant's Fiscal Officer) of said Applicant to receive and distribute funds as the authorized Fiscal Officer of the Applicant in connection with said Project; That the Applicant agrees that it will fund its portion of the cost of said Water Quality Improvement Project; That one (1) certified copy of this Resolution be prepared and sent to the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation, Albany, New York together with the Federal and State application; That this Resolution take effect immediately.
