

Minutes of an adjourned meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Monday, March 24, 1947 at 3:00 P.M.

Arthur H. Lundberg, Town Attorney was present.

The matter in regard to the alleged charges against Chester Kowalsky, Police Patrolman of the Town of Riverhead was brought to the attention of the Town Board.

Supervisor Kelly, pursuant to the rules and regulations of the Civil Service Law thereupon declared a hearing on the matter open.

William J. Hattrick, Attorney for Chester Kowalsky made a formal application to the Board for an adjournment of the hearing until April 2, 1947 at 3:30 P.M. in the Town Hall. He requested an opportunity to file an amended answer to the charges on or before March 29, 1947, a copy of which to be given to the Suffolk County Civil Service Commission. He wished to reserve all defenses and objections to April 2, 1947 at the time of the hearing. He further stated that he will file a copy of the original answer with the Civil Service Board.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Leonard it was Resolved that the requests of William J. Hattrick, Attorney, be granted. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

Supervisor Kelly adjourned the hearing to April 2, 1947 at 3:30 P.M.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Zaleski it was RESOLVED, that pursuant to Chapter 535 of the Laws of 1945, amended by Chapter 436 of the Laws of 1946, the Superintendent of Public Works of the State of New York be and is requested to make surveys and prepare plans and estimates of cost for the construction of a jetty on the beach at Wading River, Town of Riverhead, County of Suffolk, New York. This is in addition to the jetty requested for the Wading River Beach by resolution on September 11, 1946, and be it further

RESOLVED, that it is the intention of the Town of Riverhead to participate with the County of Suffolk in the cost of such construction. The Vote, Justices Warner, Yousik, Leonard and Zaleski Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes. Total Vote Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly Adopted.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, April 2, 1947 at 2:00 P.M.
