

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Clerk's Office, Monday, January 8th, 1923 at 2-00 P.M.

Minutes of previous meetings read and on motion adopted.

On motion made seconded and carried Supervisor Dennis G. Homan and Town Clerk Frank Sollar were authorized to borrow a sufficient sum of money to retire a note of December 1st. in the amount of \$ 2687.96. there being almost enough money in the Contingent Fund to pay the above note.

Justice Chauncey H.Young presented a resolution and asked for its adoption.

On motion made seconded and carried the following resolution was adopted and same to be presented to the Board of Supervisor's:

Riverhead, N.Y.
January ---- 1923.

WHEREAS; there is an important road between Wading River on the West and Mattituck on the East, a distance of approximately 15 miles, commonly called Sound Avenue. This road passes through the hamlets of Fresh Pond, Baiting Hollow, Roanoke, Sound Ave and West Mattituck.

WHEREAS; the farming community lying along this road is very highly developed, produces enormous quantities of farm produce and is unsurpassed by any equal area in the country in the value of its farm crops.

WHEREAS; this road is and will be used as a main through route for hauling these crops to market by truck

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that this Town Board use all legitimate efforts to secure the necessary legislation to have this road improved by the State.

RESOLVED; that if necessary a representative of this Town Board go to Albany to urge the passage of such legislation, working in connection with other interested parties.

AN ACT

TO AMEND THE HIGHWAY LAW BY THE ADDITION
OF A NEW STATE ROUTE IN THE COUNTY OF SUFFOLK.

The people of the State of New York, represented
in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section one hundred and twenty of Chapter
Thirty of the Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Nine, entitled
"An act relating to highways, constituting Chapter twenty
Five of the Consolidated Laws" as last amended by Chapter
three hundred and eighty eight of the laws of nineteen
hundred and twenty two, is hereby amended by adding there
to, after route thirty five thereof, a new sub-division
or route to be known as route thirty five-A. described
and to read as follows:

Route, 35-A. Commencing at the junction of Sound Ave.
and route thirty five, east of the hamlet of Wading River
thence easterly on Sound Avenue to the hamlet of Mattituck
and the junction of Sound Ave with County Highway, Forty-
Nine.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

On motion made seconded and carried this Board as
the Board of Health adopted the Amendments To Municipal
Sanitary Code along with the General Rules and Regulations
and Town Clerk was ordered to have a notice published in
the newspapers calling the attention of the public to
same. Also have a sufficient number of copies of the
above printed and same to be posted along with the General
Rules and Regulations in three or more public places in
the Town.

It was decided to hold the next meeting January 31st.
1923 at 2-00 P.M.

There being no further business meeting adjourned.
