

Minutes of a meeting of the Town board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Clerk's office, Wednesday, Jan. 31st, 1923. at 2-00 P.M.

Minutes of previous meeting read and on motion adopted.

Mr. Armstrong from the State Insurance Fund appeared before the Town Board in relation to the moneys due his company for the years 1919 and 1920. After due deliberation he was asked to submit a detailed statement, of the business done with Riverhead Town covering the periods above stated.

Mr. Bernard Lord addressed the Board in behalf of Tax Collector Clinton T. Voorhees for clerk hire for one additional week making a total of seven weeks and on motion made seconded and carried Tax Collector was empowered to hire a clerk for one week.

On motion made seconded and carried that the sum of \$ 110.00 being the amount of Henry R. Fox loan be paid.

The committee on electric lights reported and Mr. Risler was instructed to prepare a contract and present same at the next meeting.

Superintendent of Highways George H. Taft asked permission from the Board to buy as many as three road machines and the request was granted.

On motion made seconded and carried Supervisor Dennis G. Homan and Town Clerk Frank Sollar were authorized to borrow the sum of \$ 2764.99 to pay audited bills as of January 30th, 1923.

It was decided to hold the next meeting on Wednesday February 14th, at 2-00 P.M.

There being no further business meeting adjourned.
