Mr. R. E. Brooks and Mr. Owen Quinn appeared before the Board and submitted several propositions in New and second mixers.

On motion made seconded and carried Supervisor Dennis G. Homan and Sup't of Highways George H. Taft were appointed a committee to look over these new and second hand mixers and get the advise of an expert and report at the next meeting.

Mr. Charles Elton and Mr. E. P. Murphy appeared before the Board and the subject of purchasing a new safe cabinet for the Town Offices was thoroughly discussed.

On motion made seconded and carried that we purchase one # 53. M. E. Safe Cabinet equipped with one section of 6 document files and four roller shelves. The total cost being \$ 406.05 less 2% for cash within 30 days from date of shipment.

On motion made seconded and carried Justices George E. Penny and Chauncey H. Young were appointed a committee to look over the different types of tractors that would be suitable for the Town of Riverhead with power to act.

On motion made seconded and carried Supervisor Dennis G. Homan and Town Clerk Frank Sollar were authorized to borrow the sum of \$ 600.00 to pay audited bills as of March 27th, 1923.

It was decided to hold the next meeting on Thursday, April 5th, 1923 at 2-00 P.M.

There being no further business meeting adjourned.
