Minutes of previous meeting read and on motion adopted.

On motion the following resolutions were duly passed:

RESOLVED, that the resolutions or franchise duly adopted by this Board on the 25th day of August, 1913, authorizing and empowering the Consumer's Gas Company of Long Island, a corporation organized under the laws of the State of New York, to lay and maintain gas mains and gas pipes, for the purpose of selling, conducting and distributing gas in and through the highways of the Town of Riverhead, in that portion thereof, known as the Villages of Riverhead, Aquebogue and Jamesport and in the connecting and intersecting highways within such territory and within all highways now opened within the Town of Riverhead or which may be hereafter laid out and opened in the territory above described, be and the same hereby are in all respects ratified and confirmed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the time within which the Consumers' Gas Company of Long Island shall lay its gas mains and gas pipes within that portion of the Town of Riverhead, known as the Village of Riverhead and furnish gas within said territory, be and the same hereby is extended to and including the 25th day of August, 1916.

There being no further business, meeting adjourned.
