

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, October 19, 1949 at 2:00 P.M.

Arthur H. Lundberg, Town Attorney and Myron C. Young, Supt. of Highways were present.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on October 5, 1949 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

A communication was read from the Wading River Civic Association calling the Board attention to a dangerous curve in the North Wading Road near the Branagan property and asked that the curve be eliminated. The matter was referred to the Highway Committee and the Supt. of Highways.

A petition signed by several taxpayers requesting the Town to construct sidewalks on Pulaski Street from Marcy Avenue to the Town water tower and north on Raynor Avenue. The petition was ordered placed on file and the matter referred to the Highway Committee and the Supt. of Highways.

On motion made by Justice Leonard and seconded by Justice Yousik it was Resolved that the Long Island Lighting Company be authorized to place 1 - 100 C.F. street light on Pole #9 on Newton Avenue in the Riverhead Lighting District. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

A communication was read from the New York State Traffic Commission advising the Board that it had approved Town Ordinance #13 as amended, which was adopted by the Town Board on September 21, 1949. The communication was ordered placed on file.

On motion made by Justice Zaleski and seconded by Justice Leonard it was Resolved that the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead request the State Traffic Commission to prohibit the parking of vehicles on the South side of Court Street from the entrance of the Suffolk County Parking Field to Griffing Avenue. The Resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

(There being no further business on motion and vote) The Town Board convened as a Board of Audit and examined all town bills to date, the totals of which are as follows: General Town - \$647.13, Water District - \$458.80, Sewer District - \$745.37, Highway Machinery - \$38.17.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, October 26, 1949 at 7:30 P.M.
