

Minutes of a joint meeting of the Town Board and Highway Commissioner of the Town of Riverhead, held in Town Hall, Friday, March 6, 1908, at two o'clock P.M.

Meeting called for the purpose of entering into an agreement for the appropriation of the Highway money to the several roads throughout the town.

On motion the Highway Commissioner was authorized to define the following roads: North Wading River Road, 3 1/2 miles long; Tuthill's Lane, 1 1/2 miles long; Mill Road, 2 miles long, and Middle Road, 4 1/2 miles long.

On motion the Highway Commissioner was authorized to macadam Main Street from Roanoke Avenue to the west line of the property of E. W. Tooker, a distance of 380 feet, at a cost not to exceed \$1000.; bed of said road to be built of stone taken from the Sound beach.

On motion the Highway Commissioner was authorized to erect a stone bridge on the Peconic Bay Boulevard over Skillman's Creek.

On motion, Highway Commissioner was authorized to have a duplicate map made showing the highways of the town, same to be placed in the Town Clerk's office for use of the public.

On motion, the agreement for the appropriating of the Highway Funds, as offered by the Highway Commissioner, was approved, and meeting adjourned to Monday afternoon at 3 o'clock, when agreement would be signed.

The macadamizing of Peconic Avenue to meet the new Quogue Road was laid over for a later meeting.
