

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the
Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Clerk's Office,
Saturday, October 16th, 1915 at 9:00 O'clock A.M.

PRESENT:

On motion it was ordered that Board of Water Commissioners of Riverhead Water District receive a compensation of \$3.00 per day for each day actually and necessarily spent in business of the Water District from April 26th, 1915.

On motion Supervisor was authorized to transfer \$51.45 from New Highway fund and \$448.55 from Contingent Fund to General Highway Fund.

On motion the following estimate of Town Superintendent of Highways of amount of moneys which should be raised by Tax for year beginning on the 1st day of November 1915 were approved.

- For the repair and improvement of town Highways, including sluices, culverts, and bridges having a span of less than five feet \$25,000.
- For the general repair of all bridges having a span of five feet or more and not included above \$300.
- For the purchase and repair of machinery, tools and implements \$500.
- For removal of obstructions caused by snow, cutting weeds and brush, wire fencing, allowance for shade trees, allowance for water troughs and other miscellaneous purposes \$700.

There being no further business, meeting adjourned.
