

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, November 5, 1947 at 2:00 P.M.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on October 15, 1947 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

An application was read from the Quinn's Bus Line, Patchogue, New York for a renewal of a bus franchise which expired on October 30, 1947 for a period of five years from the 31st day of October, 1947 to the 30th day of October, 1952. The application was ordered placed on file.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Leonard it was Resolved that a public hearing be held on the application of the Quinn's Bus Line for a renewal of a bus franchise for a period of five years commencing on the 31st day of October, 1947 to the 30th day of October, 1952, for the transportation of passengers for hire over, along and upon the following highways, to wit: Commencing on Route 25A at the Riverhead-Brookhaven Town Line and running thence along Route 25A to Hulse Avenue; running thence along Hulse Avenue to North Wading River Road and running thence along North Wading River Road to the entrance of Wildwood State Park, said route being about two and one-half miles in length, being all within the Town of Riverhead. Said hearing to be held in the Town Hall at Riverhead, N.Y. on the 3rd day of December, 1947 at 2:00 P.M. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Leonard it was Resolved that the certification of additional membership of the Wading River Fire Dept. Inc. dated October 20, 1947 be and the same is hereby confirmed and ordered placed on file. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

The Police Report for the month of October, 1947 was submitted to the Board and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

A communication was read from Mr. Theodore Leavitt of Riverhead, N.Y. urging the Board to increase the salaries of the men on the Riverhead police force. The communication was ordered placed on file.

The Town Board then convened as a Board of Audit and examined all town and highway machinery bills to date.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, November 19, 1947 at 2:00 P.M.
