Minutes of previous meeting read and on motion adopted.

Mr. Arthur M. Tyte presented a complaint to the Town Board requesting that immediate action be taken to relieve the citizens in the section of Mr. Frank W. Satterly's Duck Farm. Mr. Tyte, in the complaint, says that the Duck Farm has damaged the property in that vicinity and is damaging the health of those living in that vicinity.

On motion, seconded and carried the complaint of Mr. Arthur M. Tyte was placed on file and Town Clerk Joseph W. Kratoville was ordered to write to Health Officer, Dr. A. G. Terrell and ask that immediate action be taken to find out whether or not the Duck Farm of Mr. Frank W. Satterly is unhealthful to that section of the Town of Riverhead.

On motion, seconded and carried Town Clerk, Joseph W. Kratoville was ordered to present to Messrs Leon and Gerald Fredericks of Jamesport, L.I. each a medal in the name of the Town of Riverhead.

On motion seconded and carried Town Clerk Joseph W. Kratoville was ordered to ascertain the cost of printing Town Records to date and report at a future meeting.
