The minutes of the meeting of December 23th. were  
read and on motion adopted

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was  
Resolved that the Supervisor be authorized to transfer \$700.  
from the Miscellaneous Fund to the Machinery Fund.

Thomas E. Greene, Overseer of the Poor, addressed  
the Board and advised that he would require the sum of  
\$36.37 to balance the Overseer of the Poor's Account for the  
year 1926.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried it was  
Resolved that the Supervisor be authorized to pay the Over-  
seer of the Poor the sum of \$36.37 from the Contingent Account  
to balance the 1926 account of the Overseer of the Poor.

The committee appointed to confer with Mr. Schafer  
and Mr. Shiebel in regard to drawing up an Ordinance regulat-  
ing traffic on Roanoke Avenue, near the school, reported a  
request would be made to the Public to obey certain regulat-  
~~ions~~ which will be published in the local papers and printed  
on hand bills and distributed about the Town.
