

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, August 21, 1946 at 2:00 P.M.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on August 7, 1946 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

The matter in regard to the purchase of new street signs was discussed by the Board and on motion and vote was referred to the Highway Committee and Supt. of Highways.

A petition from Henry W. Adelwerth was presented to the Board requesting their consent to the operation of a motor bus line on highways in the Town of Riverhead. The petition was ordered placed on file.

On motion made by Justice Zaleski and seconded by Justice Leonard it was Resolved that the Town Board hold a public hearing on the petition of Henry W. Adelwerth to operate a motor bus line on the highways of the Town of Riverhead and that such hearing be held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, September 11, 1946 at 2:00 P.M. and further that the Town Clerk be authorized to publish such notice as required by law. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

A notice from the New York State Public Service Commission advising the Board that a public hearing will be held before Commissioner Arkwright in the office of the Commission, 233 Broadway, New York, N.Y. on Thursday, August 29, 1946 at 11:00 A.M. on the matter of increased omnibus fares of Robert R. Brown. The notice was ordered placed on file.

On motion and vote the Town Clerk was instructed to write to the Public Service Commission for a schedule of the proposed increase of fares of Robert R. Brown.

The matter of laying the allotted sidewalks for 1946 in the Town of Riverhead was discussed by the Board and on motion and vote the Highway Committee and the Supt. of Highways were authorized to study the various petitions and use their judgement in apportioning such sidewalks as to necessity.

On motion made by Justice Yousik and seconded by Justice Leonard it was Resolved that Marion Worth be appointed a temporary Junior Clerk to the Board of Assessors, salary fixed at the rate of \$5.00 per day. The Vote Justices Warner, Yousik, Leonard and Zaleski Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes. Total Vote Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Leonard it was Resolved that Stephen Grodski be provisionally appointed as Special Policeman or as classified by the rules of Civil Service as Police Patrolman of the Town of Riverhead, said appointment retroactive as of August 16, 1946, salary fixed at the rate of \$2200.00 per year payable semi-monthly. The Vote, Justices Warner, Yousik, Leonard and Zaleski Yes, Supervisor Kally Yes. Total Vote yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

The Town Board then convened as a Board of Audit and examined all town bills to date.

There being no further business an motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, August 28, 1946 at 2:00 P.M.
