

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, August 9, 1944 at 2:00 P.M.

Arthur H. Lundberg, Town Attorney and Myron C. Young Supt. of Highways were present.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on July 19, 1944 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

A communication was read from the Riverhead Chamber of Commerce, stating that a resolution was adopted by that body to the effect that Reeves Beach might be improved by having the moss covered stones, which are exposed at low tide and which form a dangerous obstacle to bathers at high tide, removed. The communication was ordered placed on file.

A communication signed by eleven people residing at Reeves Park, requesting that a sign reading, SLOW-CHILDREN AT PLAY, be placed on Park Avenue leading to the beach for the protection of the children of that community was read. The matter was referred to the Supt. of Highways.

The Police and Welfare reports for the month of July 1944 were submitted to the Board and on motion and vote were ordered placed on file.

Proof of publication and posting of Riverhead Town Ordinance No. 11, defining and providing for the regulation of the business of Pawnbroker and the operation of Pawnshops were submitted to the Board and ordered placed on file.

Supervisor Kelly submitted his report for the month of July 1944 and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file.

A certified copy of a resolution which was duly adopted by the Suffolk County Board of Supervisors fixing Monday, November 27, 1944, as the date of the meeting of that Board at which taxes for the next fiscal year will be levied, was submitted to the Town Board and on motion and vote was ordered placed on file.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Leonard it was Resolved, that Norman J. Bruen be and he hereby is appointed Attendance Supervisor for School Districts Nos. 1, 2, 3, 4, 13 and 13 in the Town of Riverhead, and be further

Resolved, that Howard A. Wells be and he hereby is appointed Attendance Supervisor for School Districts Nos. 8, 9, 10 and 11 in the Town of Riverhead, and be it further

Resolved, that their compensation be fixed at the rate of \$250.00 per school year each, payable in ten monthly payments, which compensation shall include all expenses other than those incurred when attending meetings outside of the Town of Riverhead, called by the District Superintendent of Schools, at which time actual expenses are to be paid by the Town of Riverhead. The Vote, Justices Warner, Yousik, Leonard and Smith Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes. Total Vote, Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

On motion made by Justice Warner and seconded by Justice Yousik it was Resolved, that John Bilski be appointed Police Patrolman of the Town of Riverhead at the pleasure of the Board, said appointment to be effective as of August 15, 1944, salary fixed at the base rate of \$2000.00 per annum. The Vote, Justices Warner, Yousik, Leonard and Smith Yes, Supervisor Kelly Yes. Total Vote Yes 5, No 0. The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

The Town Board then convened as a Board of Audit and examined all Town bills to date.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, August 23, 1944 at 2:00 P.M.
