

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board, as a Board of Audit, held in the Town Clerk's Office Thursday, Nov. 13, 1902, at 9 o'clock, A. M.

On motion the Justices of the Peace were appointed a Committee on Constable and Sheriff's bills and the full Board acted on all other bills, except that members had no voice in the auditing of their own bills.

The report of the Overseer of the Poor was presented and accepted.

77 Bills amounting to \$1622.39 and 11 Board of Health Bills amounting to \$201.05, were audited.

On motion the sum of \$500. was appropriated to the Overseer of the Poor, out of the Contingent fund.

On motion the Supervisor was authorized by the Board, to insert in the tax levy the sum of \$156.25 for the laying out of a highway in the Village of Riverhead, as certified to be necessary for such purpose by Geo. W. Hildreth, R. W. Penny and Harvey P. Fanning, Commissioners appointed by order of the County Court of Suffolk County, dated April 7, 1902.

Supervisor presented his statement which was approved.
