

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Clerk's office Wednesday, Jan. 28th, 1925 at 2-00 P.M.

Minutes of meeting of January 12th read and on motion adopted.

The committee on electric lights reported that a street light was necessary on Mc Dermott Avenue between the Main Road and the Town Dock.

On motion duly made seconded and carried it was resolved that the Long Island Lighting Co. be directed, in accordance with its terms of the contract, to install a street light on Mc Dermott Avenue about midway between the Main Road and the Town Dock.

The Town Clerk read the annual report of Local Historian Horace H. Williamson filed on January 12th 1925.

On motion duly made seconded and carried it was resolved that the Supervisor and Justice Penny attend the hearing of the Public Service Commission to appose the application of the Long Island Railroad Co to discontinue the services of its agent at the Laurel Station, and that this board is hereby apposed to such application.

Messrs William R. Fanning and Ralph C. Brown, representing the Lions Club, addressed the board relative to the town board providing for a suitable place and means to dump rubbish.

On motion duly made seconded and carried it was resolved that the board recommend the Superintendent of Highways that an advertisement stating the location of the premises leased for the dumping of rubbish be published in both local papers by him and that he place suitable signs in suitable localities to the same effect.

On motion duly made seconded and carried it was resolved that the Supervisor and Town Clerk be and they are hereby authorized and directed to borrow the sum of \$ 2000.00 to pay audited bills of January 27th, 1925.

On motion duly made seconded and carried it was resolved that the services of the Clerk to the tax receiver be extended for a period of four weeks.

On motion duly made seconded and carried the board adjourned to meet on February 16th 1925 at 2:00 P.M.
