

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, February 25, 1948 at 2:00 P.M.

Arthur H. Lundberg, Town Attorney and Myron C. Young Supt. of Highways were present.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on February 11, 1948 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

Mr. Polley and Mr. Doran representatives of the Mico Parking Meter explained in detail the workings of their meter and the agreement that their Company would offer to the Town of Riverhead, should the Board accept this meter.

Roanoke Heights Development Corporation requested the Board to abandon part of McDonald Place, all of Marlor Road, all that part of Hallock Street east of a line drawn parallel with Roanoke Avenue and 550 feet easterly thereof, all of VanVelsor Road and all of Pine Way as shown on map filed on November 14, 1936, for the reason that the aforesaid highways have not been opened or worked for more than six years last past and that the same have been abandoned by the public and that they never were used as a public highway or highways. The aforesaid Corporation also submitted a dedication of Heights Place as shown on map dated February 13, 1948 and filed in the Town Road Record on February 25, 1948. All of which have been submitted and approved by the Riverhead Town Planning Board.

Justice Leonard offered the following Resolution which was seconded by Justice Warner

WHEREAS, the Roanoke Heights Development Corporation has submitted a "Certificate of Abandonment" of part of McDonald Place, all of Marlor Road, all that part of Hallock Street east of a line drawn parallel with Roanoke Avenue and 550 feet easterly thereof, all of VanVelsor Road and all of Pine Way. as shown on Map filed in the Town Road Record on November 14, 1936, and

WHEREAS, the said Corporation has submitted a dedication of a street known as "Heights Place" as shown on map filed in the Town Road Record on February 25, 1948, and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid Certificate of Abandonment and the dedication of Heights Place have been submitted and approved by the Riverhead Town Planning Board, now therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the aforesaid "Certificate of Abandonment" dated February 25, 1948, and the aforesaid dedication of Heights Place as a town highway, situated in Roanoke Heights, be and the same are hereby accepted by the Town of Riverhead, and further

RESOLVED, that the Certificate of Abandonment, and the map and dedication of Heights Place be placed on file in the Town Road Record and that a new map of the present Town Highways on the East side of Roanoke Heights be prepared and made a part of the highway record. The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Board.

A communication was read from the Sigal Realty Company stating that it is planning for the construction of a new building on the north side of East Main Street and in as much as it is now in the blue print stage, they would like to know whether or not the town has any intentions of doing anything with the sidewalk in front of their property which is now 12 to 15 inches above the normal curb step-up. The matter was referred to the Highway Committee and the Supt. of Highways for investigation and report.

The Town Board then convened as a Board of Audit and examined all town and highway machinery bills to date.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, March 3, 1948 at 9:00 A.M.
