Board of Town Officers of the Town of Riverhead met at the Town Clerk's Office Thursday June 18' 1896 at 2 o'clock P.M.

All members present.

On motion of George F. Stackpole, the following resolution was unanimously adopted.

RESOLVED:- That the Commissioner of Highways be requested to enforce the law in relation to Bicycle riding on the sidewalks in the Village of Riverhead, on the Main Street. between Union Street and Osborn Avenue and on Roanoke and Griffing Avenues South of the Railroad; and on all side walks in the Village of South Jamesport.

On motion of George F. Stackpole, the Board recommended that the Commissioner of Highways, regulate the speed of vehicles and bicycles in the Village of Riverhead and South Jamesport, at a speed not exceeding six miles per hour, was unanimously adopted.

Minutes read and adopted and the meeting adjourned.
