Minutes of a Meeting of the Town Board of the Town
of Riverhead, held in the Town Clerk's Office, Monday, June
29th, 1914 at 2:00 O'clock P.M.

On motion it was ordered that the Meetings of this
Board be held at 3:30 O'clock P.M. instead of 2:00 O'clock
P.M. except in such cases where it is absolutely essential
that same be held at a different time.

On motion the following election districts were
laid out and defined as follows:

District #1 is laid out and defined as follows:

Begins at the intersection of the southerly line of
Long Island Sound, the easterly line of the Town of Brookhaven
and the Westerly line of the Town of Riverhead; thence follows
the Easterly line of the Town of Brookhaven till it comes
to the centre line of Peconic River; thence follows the centre
line of Peconic River to its intersection with the continuation
of the centre line of Fresh Pond Avenue; thence follows the
centre line of Fresh Pond Avenue to Sound Avenue; thence
follows a line, which would be a direct continuation northerly
of the centre line of Fresh Pond Avenue to Long Island Sound.
thence follows the shore of Long Island Sound to beginning.

District #2 is laid out and defined as follows:

Begins at the point of intersection of the Easterly line
of District #1 and the southerly line of Long Island Sound;
thence follows said Easterly line of District #1 to the
centre line of Peconic River, thence follows the centre line
of Peconic River to a point in the Village of Riverhead, which
would be the continuation southerly of the easterly line of
Fisher's Bakery Property; thence following said line northerly
along the easterly line of Fishers Bakery Property and to
the centre line of Main Street; thence following the centre

line of Main Street west until it intersects the centre line of Osborn Avenue; thence following the centre line of Osborn Avenue to Sound Avenue; thence following a line, which would be the continuation northerly of the centre line of Osborn Avenue to Long Island Sound; thence following the shore of Long Island Sound to the place of beginning.

District #3 is laid out and defined as follows:

Beginning at the point of intersection of the easterly line of district #2 and southerly line of Long Island Sound thence following the easterly line of district #2 to the centre line of Main Street; thence following the line of said District #2 along the centre line of Main Street to its intersection with the centre line of Roanoke Avenue; thence following the centre line of Roanoke Avenue to the centre line of the Main Track of the Long Island Railroad Company; thence following the centre line of the Main Track to the centre line of Union Street; thence following Union Street northerly along its centre line to its intersection with the centre line of Northville Turnpike; thence following the centre line of the Northville Turnpike to its intersection with the centre line of Sound Avenue and thence following the centre line of Sound Avenue easterly to its intersection with the centre line of Penney's Road; thence following the centre line of Penney's Road to Long Island Sound, thence following the shore of the Long Island Sound westerly to the place of beginning.

District #4 is laid out and defined as follows:

Begins at the point of intersection of the easterly line of district #3 and the southerly line of Long Island Sound; thence following the shore of the Long Island Sound easterly to a point, which would be the continuation northerly of the centre line of West land; thence following said line to Sound Avenue; thence following the centre line of West land to its intersection with the northerly line of School District #8; thence westerly following the northerly line of School District #8 to its intersection with the north line of School District #7; thence following the north line of School District #7 to its intersection with the centre line of Union Avenue; thence following the centre line of Union Avenue to the centre line of Main Road; thence westerly along the centre line of Main Road to Poor land; thence following the centre line of Poor Lane to the Long Island Railroad; thence following the centre line of Terry's Creek by Indian Island and on until it reaches the southerly line of the Town of Riverhead; thence westerly along the southerly line of the Town of Riverhead to a point, which be the continuation southerly



of the easterly line of Fisher's Bakery Property; thence following said line northerly to the centre line of Main Street; thence following along the easterly, southerly again Easterly, southeasterly and Easterly line of District #3 to the point or place of beginning.

District #5 is laid out and defined as follows:
Begins at a point of intersection of the easterly line of District #4 and the southerly line of Long Island Sound; thence following the southerly line of Long Island Sound Easterly to the westerly boundary of the Town of Southold; thence southerly along the division line of the Town of Southold and the Town of Riverhead to the southerly line of the Town of Riverhead; thence westerly along the southerly line of the Town of Riverhead to its intersection with the Easterly line of district #4; thence following the easterly, southerly, easterly, again southerly and again easterly lines of the district #4 to the place of beginning.

On motion Town Clerk was directed to have a Map of such Election Districts completed and obtain twelve copies of such Map for Town and Election Officials.
