

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board, as a Board of Auditors. held in the Town Clerks Office, Thurs. Nov. 14, 1901, at 9 o'clock. P.M.

On motion the meeting adjourned to Town Hall.

On motion the Justices of the Peace were appointed a Committee on constables and sheriffs Bills, and the full Board acted on all other bills except that members had no voice in the auditing of their own bills.

12 O'clock noon. Recess taken until 1.30 P.M.

1.30 Board re-assembled.

The report of the Overseer of the Poor was presented and on motion approved. X

68 Bills amounting to \$1728.38 and 12 Board of Health Bills amounting to \$217.65 were audited.

The Comm. of Highways presented several highway bills which were approved by Board.

On motion the sum of \$250. was appropriated to the Board of Health ~~for~~ the Contingent fund.

On motion of Geo. A. Buckingham, the sum of \$520.94 was appropriated to the Overseer of the Poor., out of the Contingent fund.



On motion of Justice Buckingham, the Supervisor was authorized to borrow on the credit of the Town, the sum \$2000, upon a note to be signed by the Supervisor and Town Clerk; the same to be credited to the Contingent fund of said Town.

On motion of Justice Buckingham the sum of \$250 be taken from the contingent fund and placed to the credit of the Board of Helath.

On motion the Supervisor was instructed to pay to Henry A. Barnum Post. G.A.R., the sum of \$34.81 from the contingent fund for Memorial Day expenses for 1901.
