The Town Clerk read petition of 25 Taxpayers praying for Contract for lighting the Streets in Lighting Dist. #1, whereupon, Justice Buckingham offered the following resolution, which was adopted.

RESOLVED: that the Town Board advertise for bids for furnishing incandescent electric lights for lighting the streets in Lighting District No. 1 of said Town, of twenty-five (25) candle power lamps, each night in the year from one half hour after sundown until 1 o'clock A.M. for a term of three (3) years from Febry. 19' 1900; said bids to state the number of lights that will be furnished at an annual cost not to exceed \$1000; said lights to be located at such places as the Town Board shall designate in said Lighting District.

On motion the Town Clerk was instructed to prepare necessary notice and attend to the publication of the same; bids to be received by the Town Board at its next meeting. On motion the meeting adjourned to meet at the Town Clerk's Office, Monday, January 29' 1900 at 2 o'clock P.M. John Bageliau
