

MINUTES of a Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Clerk's Office, Monday, January 26th, 1914, at 2:00 P.M.

PRESENT:

Petition was presented signed by a number of persons requesting that a Street light be erected and maintained on Main Street in the Village of Riverhead approximately 750 feet west of Griffing Avenue.

On motion the Petition was granted and Supervisor, Corwin was instructed to have such light placed.

Petition was presented requesting the establishment of a separate and distinct lighting district in the Town of Riverhead to be known as Lighting District #2 and to be established in the following boundaries of said Town:

On the south by Peconic River; on the East by the West line of the present lighting district; on the north by the Long Island Railroad and on the West by property belonging to the Barrow Estate.

On motion the petition was ordered placed on file and on motion it was ordered ^{that} an opinion be obtained from the Town Attorney as to the legality of said petition

and as to what further steps the Board must take in order
to properly establish the District.
