

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Hall on Wednesday, January 13, 1937 at 9:00 A. M.

Minutes of a meeting of the Town Board held on December 30, 1936 were read and on motion and vote were duly adopted.

A communication from Mrs. Robert T. Oliver, Assistant Supervisor, Service Projects, W. P. A. dated January 4, 1937 together with a report of the Federal Surplus Commodities Stores for the period of November 26 to December 25, 1936 were read and ordered placed on file.

The Supervisor's Annual report for the fiscal year ending December 31, 1936 and the Supervisor's report for the month of December, 1936 pursuant to law were submitted to the Board and on motion and vote were accepted and ordered placed on file.

The annual report of the special Police of the Town of Riverhead was submitted by Thomas J. Walker, Special Officer in charge and on motion and vote was accepted and ordered placed on file as follows:

Justice Warner offered the following resolution which was seconded by Justice Kelly

WHEREAS Bond #NYBO-07-29-37 of the U.S. Fidelity and Guaranty Company bonding Milton L. Burns, As Supervisor of the Town of Riverhead, in the amount of \$40,000, has been presented for the year 1937 and

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WHEREAS Bond #NYBO-07-5-36 of the U. S. Fidelity and Guaranty Co., in the amount of \$40,000, for the period January 1, 1936 to December 31, 1936 was approved by the Town Board on December 12, 1935 and

WHEREAS Bond #NYBO-07-5-36 was for a period of two years unless cancelled, now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED that Bond #NYBO-07-5-36 be cancelled effective as of January 1, 1937 and Bond #NYBO-07-29-37 for the year 1937 be and the same hereby is approved as to form and the sufficiency of the surety. The resolution was carried by the unanimous vote of the Board.

A complaint from Mr. Samuel Alper relative to the drainage of surface water at the corner of Railroad Avenue and Osborn Avenue was referred to the Highway Committee for investigation and report.

A request of Mr. Eugene Ruland in regard to changing a street light on Railroad Avenue between Roanoke Avenue and Griffin Avenue was referred to the Lighting Committee.

The Town Board then convened as a Board of Audit and examined the Town bills to date.

There being no further business on motion and vote the meeting adjourned to meet on Wednesday, January 27, 1937 at 9:00 A. M.
