

MINUTES of a Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead, held in the Town Clerk's Office, Monday, March 30th, 1914 at 2:00 P. M.

After careful consideration of the needs of road improvement throughout the Town, an agreement for the apportionment of Highway Moneys for the year 1914 was entered into between the Town Board of the Town of Riverhead and Town Superindendent of Highways, William A. Brown and a copy of such agreement duly filed in the Town Clerk's Office.

On motion, J. Frederick Dugan was appointed Registrar of Vital Statistics in and for the Town of Riverhead for a term of four years ~~from~~ January 1, 1914.

A-petition was presented signed by Chas. H. Hempstead and others constituting a majority of the Tax payers of the District hereinafter mentioned praying for the establishment of a Lighting District in the Town of Riverhead, Suffolk County, N.Y. to be known as lighting district No. 2 and to be established within the boundaries of said Town as follows:

Bounded on the South by Peconic River, on the East by the West line of the present lighting district, on the north by the Long Island Railroad and on the West by property belonging to the Darrow Estate.

On motion it was ordered that at least one weeks notice of above application be given by publication thereof in the "Riverhead News" and "County Review". The notice to specify the filing of the Petition and time and place when the same will be acted upon by the Board and that at least seven days notice after publication and before return day be given

On motion, Town Clerk was instructed to write Mr. C.M. Blydenburgh requesting his offer in writing for release of his rights in River Street and land under water adjacent thereto.

There being no further business, meeting adjourned.
