

MINUTES of a Meeting of the Town Board of the Town
of Riverhead, held in the Town Hall, Tuesday, June 10th, 1913,
at 1:00 O'clock P. M.:

Meeting called to order by Supervisor

Notice of meeting to consider application for formation
of Water district, dated May 26th, 1913, for this time and
place read by Clerk.

Affidavits of publication of notice of meeting received
and filed.

Supervisor, Dwight T. Corwin invited discussion of the
question of action by Town Board on the petition for formation
of such district, filed May 23d, 1913.

Subject discussed by members of Board and Tax Payers
present.

Mr Hildreth moved that the Supervisor and Town Clerk be
appointed a committee to confer with Nathan D. and Nathan O.
Petty, Attorneys for purpose of determining if the petition
for such district is in due form and meets the requirements
of law applicable to the formation of such districts,
committee to report at an adjourned meeting of Board.
seconded and carried.

Mr. Hildred moved that this Board now adjourn to the 10th

day of July, 1913 at the Town Hall, in the Village and Town of Riverhead, New York, so far as relates to the proceedings in the formation of such district, for the purpose of receiving the report of said Committee. seconded and carried.

On motion Supervisor was instructed to Transfer \$500.00 from Contingent to Overseer of Poor Fund.

There being no further business, meeting adjourned.
