On motion duly made seconded and carried it was resolved that an additional street light be and the same is hereby ordered installed on the first pole south of the L.I.R.R. crossing on the east side of Maple Avenue under the street lighting contract of the Long Island Lighting Company.


On motion duly made seconded and carried it was resolved that the Supervisor and Town Clerk be and they are hereby authorized and directed to borrow the sum of \$ 6250.00 in anticipation of taxes, to pay the bonds and interest of the Riverhead Water District.

On motion duly made seconded and carried it was resolved that the Supervisor and the Town Clerk be and they hereby are authorized and directed to borrow the sum of \$ 4500.00 to pay audited bills of November 24th, 1925.

On motion duly made seconded and carried the receiver of Taxes was authorized to employ a clerk for a period of 8 weeks at a salary of \$ 30.00 per week.

On motion duly made seconded and carried it was resolved that the Assessors be authorized to employ an additional clerk for a period of 4 weeks at a salary of \$ 25.00 per week, and that the appointment of Teresa M. Smith as such clerk by the Assessors on Nov 16th, 1925 be and the same is hereby ratified and confirmed.

On motion duly made seconded and carried the board adjourned to meet at the Town Clerk's office Monday December 14th, 1925 at 2-00 P.M.
