This Board having canvassed and estimated the votes given in the several Election Districts of said Town at a Town Meeting held at the time of the general Election on Tuesday, November 5th, 1912, do hereby certify, determine and declare that:

DWIGHT T. CORWIN, by the greatest number of votes was duly elected Supervisor in and for said Town.

J. FRED DUGAN, by the Greatest number of votes was duly elected Town Clerk in and for said Town.

GEORGE W. HILDRETH and D. ELLSWORTH WARNER, by the greatest number of votes were severally duly elected Justices of the Peace in and for said Town.

CHARLES P. KRATOVILLE, by the greatest number of votes was duly elected Assessor for Two Years in and for said Town.

BENJAMIN P. YOUNG, by the greatest number of votes was duly elected Assessor for Four Years in and for said Town.

ASA D. FORDHAM, by the Greatest Number of votes was duly elected Overseer of the Poor in and for said Town.

WILLIAM A. BROWN, by the greatest number of votes was duly elected Town Superintendent of Highways in and for said Town.

BYRON ROGERS, by the greatest number of votes was duly elected Collector in and for said Town.

WILMOT L'HOMMEDIU, by the greatest number of votes was duly elected Game Constable in and for said Town.

LEONARD P. SANFORD, SELDON HEATLEY, WILLIAM H. DAYTON, and W. ARTHUR NUGENT, by the greatest number of votes were severally duly elected Constables in and for said Town.

ROBERT P. GRIFFING, ORVIS H. LUCE and VERNON H. DOWNS, by the greatest number of votes were severally duly elected Town Auditors in and for said Town.

GEORGE H. PERKINS, by the greatest Number of votes was duly elected School Director in and for said Town.

This Board having canvassed and estimated the votes relative to the following propositions given in the several election districts in the said Town at a Town Meeting held at the time of the General Election on Tuesday, November 5th, 1912.

Proposition #1-- Shall there be inserted in the Tax Levy for the years 1913 and 1914, the sum of Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars for the Contingent Fund?

Proposition #2-- Shall there be inserted in the Tax Levy for the years 1913 and 1914, the sum of Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars for the Board of Health Fund?

Proposition #3-- Shall there be inserted in the Tax Levy for the years 1913 and 1914, the sum of Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars for the Overseer of the Poor Fund?

Proposition #4-- Shall there be inserted in the Tax levy for the years 1913 and 1914, the sum of Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars for the proper observance of Memorial Day, said sum to be payable to the Commander of Henry A. Barnum Post, G. M. R., of Riverhead, N. Y.?

Proposition #5-- Shall there be inserted in the Tax Levy for the years 1913 and 1914, the sum of Ninety-Six (\$96.00) Dollars for payment of the rent of the post rooms of Henry A. Barnum Post, G. A. R., Riverhead, N.Y.?

Do hereby certify, determine and declare that the total number of votes given for proposition #1 was 334 and the total number of votes against proposition #1 was 360.

Do hereby certify, determine and declare that the total number of votes given for proposition #2 was 359 and the total number of votes against proposition #2 was 315.

Do hereby certify, determine and declare that the total number of votes given for proposition #3 was 394 and the total number of votes against proposition #3 was 291.

Do hereby certify, determine and declare that the total number of votes given for proposition #4 was 403 and the total number of votes against proposition #4 was 289.

Do hereby certify, determine and declare that the total number of votes given for proposition #5 was 371 and the total number of votes against proposition #5 was 315.

Supervisor, DWIGHT T. CORWIN submitted his Highway
report for the past year and on motion same was accepted
and approved.

On motion the following resolutions were adopted.

RESOLVED, that Dwight T. Corwin, Supervisor of the
Town of Riverhead be instructed to insert in the Tax levy for
the Year 1913 of the Town of Riverhead, the sum of \$16000.00
for Highway purposes.

RESOLVED, that Dwight T. Corwin, Supervisor of the
Town of Riverhead be instructed to insert in the Tax levy for
the year 1913 of the Town of Riverhead, the sum of \$200.00
for repair and construction of Bridges, having a span of 5
feet or more and not included in above item for Highway
purposes.

RESOLVED, that Dwight T. Corwin, Supervisor of the
Town of Riverhead be instructed to insert in the Tax Levy for
the year 1913 of the Town of Riverhead, the sum of \$500.00
for the purchase and repair of Machinery, Tools and Implements.

RESOLVED, that Dwight T. Corwin, Supervisor of the Town of Riverhead be instructed to insert in the Tax levy for the year 1913 of the Town of Riverhead, the sum of \$500.00 for removal of obstructions caused by snow, cutting Weeds and Brush, Wire fencing, Allowance for shade Trees, allowance for Watering Troughs, and other miscellaneous purposes.

RESOLVED, that Dwight T. Corwin, Supervisor of the Town of Riverhead be instructed to insert in the Tax levy for the year 1913 of the Town of Riverhead, the sum of \$1000.00 for services of the Town Superintendent of Highways of the Town of Riverhead.

RESOLVED, that Dwight T. Corwin, Supervisor of the Town of Riverhead be instructed to insert in the Tax levy for the Year 1913 of the Town of Riverhead, the sum of \$1000.00 for the purpose of maintaining a Town Board of Health.

RESOLVED, that Dwight T. Corwin, Supervisor of the Town of Riverhead be instructed to insert in the Tax levy for the year 1913 of the Town of Riverhead, the sum of \$4500.00 or as much thereof as may be necessary for the purpose of Contingent Fund.

RESOLVED, that Dwight T. Corwin, Supervisor of the Town of Riverhead be instructed to insert in the Tax levy (to be assessed, levied and collected upon the Taxable property within the Riverhead Lighting District #1) for the year 1913 of the Town of Riverhead, the sum of \$2200.00 or as much thereof as may be necessary for the purposes of lighting the Village of Riverhead within the Lighting District.

RESOLVED, that Dwight T. Corwin, Supervisor of the Town of Riverhead be instructed to insert in the Tax levy (to be assessed, levied and collected upon the Taxable property within the Riverhead Lighting District #2) for the year 1913 of the Town of Riverhead, the sum of \$250.00 or as much thereof as may be necessary for the purposes of Lighting the Village of Riverhead within the Lighting District.

RESOLVED, that Dwight T. Corwin, Supervisor of the Town of Riverhead be instructed to insert in the Tax levy for the year 1913, of the Town of Riverhead, the sum of \$50.00 for the expenses in observance of Memorial Day.

RESOLVED that Dwight T. Corwin, Supervisor of the Town of Riverhead be instructed to insert in the Tax levy for the year 1913 of the Town of Riverhead, the sum of \$96.00 for payment of wall rent of G. A.R. Post of Riverhead

RESOLVED that Dwight T. Corwin, Supervisor of the Town of Riverhead be instructed to insert in the Tax levy for the year 1913 of the Town of Riverhead, the sum of \$500.00 for the purposes of supporting the Town Poor of the Town of Riverhead.

RESOLVED, that Dwight T. Corwin, Supervisor of the Town of Riverhead be instructed to insert in the Tax Levy (to be assessed, levied and collected upon the Taxable property within the Riverhead Fire district) for the Year 1913 of the Town of Riverhead the sum of \$1325- for the purpose of maintaining a Fire Department.

On motion the Supervisor was allowed the sum of \$300. for his services under Sec. 110 of the Highway law

On motion the Town Clerk was allowed the sum of \$25. for his services under sec. 110 of the Highway law.
