Minutes of a Meeting of the Town Board of the Town
of Riverhead, held in the Town Clerk's office, Thursday
December 26th, 1912, at 3:30 P. M.

Meeting called for the purpose of entering into
an agreement for the apportionment of the Highway moneys
of the year 1913. After a very careful study and thorough
investigation as to the needs of road improvement through-
out the Town an agreement for apportionment of Highway
Moneys was entered into between the Town Board of the Town
of Riverhead and Town Superintendant of Highways William
A. Brown and a copy of such agreement duly filed in the
Town Clerk's Office.

On motion Dwight T. Corwin and J. Fred Dugan were
appointed a committee to ascertain the cost of Fire proof
filing Cabinets and if possible obtain an offer for the safe

owned by the Town.

On motion the Town Board authorized Dwight T. Corwin, Supervisor to pay Elihu Miller of Wading River, \$100.00 for land to be acquired by the Town of Riverhead of said Elihu Miller and described as follows:

Beginning at a certain concrete monument placed at the intersection of the South Line of the Main highway with the dividing line between properties of the Religious Society of Wading River, and of E. S. Miller, and running thence S. 40° 23' 00" E. 84.65 feet to a marble monument on the south line of the present highway; thence S. 2° 58' 00" E. 103.15 feet along the south line of the highway to a concrete monument; thence N. 11° 11' 15" W. 99.35 feet to a point; thence N. 30° 17' 30" W. 81.00 feet to the point or place of beginning. Containing 0.031 acres.

On motion it was ordered that the Town Board petition the legislature for an appropriation to be used in digging out the Peconic River.

On motion the bills of Frank H. Hill & Bro. and William D. Outerbridge were laid on the Table.

There being no further business, Meeting adjourned.
