Two Petitions(both signed by a number of Citizens)
were presented to this Board,praying for the removal of the
so-called fountain at the corner of Peconic Avenue and Main
Street in Riverhead Village,and reciting that said fountain
is a dangerous obstruction to travel on said public streets
and dangerous to life and property-

On Motion ordered that the above mentioned
Petitions be granted and that the Town Superintendent of
Highways be authorized and instructed to remove same and re
store that part of the highway where said Fountain is now
located to its original condition.


On Motion ordered that if Electric Lights were
deemed necessary in the discretion of the majority of the
members of this Board,same should be placed on both corners
of Main Street and Peconic Avenue-

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On Motion Supervisor, Dwight T. Corwin was authorized to borrow an Amount in the sum of \$500 for a term of six months from date and place same to the credit of the Contingent Fund of this Town.

On Motion Town Clerk, J. Fred Dugan was authorized to purchase, or have constructed, a Cabinet to be used for filing of Maps and Surveys, belonging to the Town of Riverhead at a cost not to exceed Twenty-Dollars-
