### DETERMINES ENVIRONMENTAL SIGNIFICANCE AND AUTHORIZES TOWN CLERK TO PUBLISH AND POST NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING – SPECIAL PERMIT – RIVERHEAD LANDING LP

COUNCILMAN KWASNA offered the following resolution which  
was seconded by COUNCILMAN LULL

**WHEREAS**, the Riverhead Town Board is in receipt of an amended special permit petition from Riverhead Landing, LP to allow the construction of forty-four (44) one (1) bedroom garden apartment units additional to the existing 156 units existing on the subject real property located at Middle Road, Riverhead; such real property more particularly described as SCTM No. 0600-101-2-6.1, and

**WHEREAS**, the Planning Department has reviewed the EAF supporting the petition and has recommended that the action be considered Unlisted and that there exist no significant impacts upon either the natural or social environment and that an Environmental Impact Statement need not be prepared, and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Board desires to hold a public hearing on the subject petition, and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Board has carefully considered the merits of the petition, the SEQRA record created to date, the report of the Planning Department, the report of the Planning Board, as well as all other relevant planning, zoning and environmental information, now

**THEREFORE, BE IT**

**RESOLVED**, that in the matter of the special permit petition of Riverhead Landing, LP, the Riverhead Town Board hereby declares itself to be the Lead Agency, and

**BE IT FURTHER**

**RESOLVED**, that the Town Board hereby determines the action to be Unlisted without generating significant impacts upon either the natural or social environment and that an Environmental Impact Statement need not be prepared, and

**RESOLVED**, that the Town Board hereby authorizes the Town Clerk to publish and post the attached notice of public hearing in the official newspaper of the Town of Riverhead.
